

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

### You have voluntarily chosen to attend Catholic Therapist Retreat:

- Registrations are not transferable between persons or events.
- This event is for attendees 18 years old and older.
- By attending this event, you consent to any photographs and/or video footage that may be taken for promotional, commercial, or distributional purposes.
- By registering for this Retreat, you accepted the Terms & Conditions and agree to the Participation Agreement below:

### ALYSSA DE LA TORRE COUNSELING TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ATTENDANCE & PARTICIPATION

These are the terms and conditions (the “Participation Agreement”) governing your participation in any Alyssa de la Torre Counseling (“AdlTC”) event (“Retreat”) or owned and operated events (“Retreats”). By registering for AdlTC Retreat, you agree to these terms, which form a binding legal contract between AdlTC and the registered participant (“you” or “Participant”).

#### Participant Requirements

Access. Your registration entitles you to access the Retreat for which you have registered. Any and all other costs associated with your attendance shall be borne solely by you, and AdlTC shall have no liability for such costs.

#### Prohibited Conduct

Disruptive Conduct. You acknowledge and agree that AdlTC reserves the right to remove you from the Retreat if in its sole discretion, determines that your participation or behavior creates a disruption or hinders the Retreat or the enjoyment of the Retreat content by other attendees.

Recording, Live Streaming, and Videotaping. Participants may not photograph, record or broadcast audio or video of sessions at Company Retreat without sole consent of other retreat attendees.

Unethical/Non-Compliant Business Practices. AdlTC reserves the right to deny participation to anyone who engages in or is reputed to engage in unethical or non-compliant business practices.

#### Fees & Registration

Fees. Registration is \$55 per person.

Payment. The payment of the applicable fee for the Retreat is due upon registration. If such payment is insufficient or declined for any reason AdlTC may refuse to allow you to access the Retreat and shall have no liability in that regard.

Taxes. The fees may be subject to sales tax, value added tax, or other taxes and duties which, if applicable, will be charged to you in addition to the fees.

Cancellation and Refund policy. If you cancel your registration by October 20, 2023, you will receive a full refund minus a credit card processing fee of approximately 3%. If you cancel your registration by October 27, 2023, then you will receive a refund of \$30.00 minus a credit card processing fee of approximately 3%. No refunds will be provided after October 27, 2023. No refunds will be provided

on the day of the retreat (i.e. No refunds during/after the retreat).
